PrepGently wash and

dry the area of the skin

to be treated



Apply

Spread a thin layer of WINLEVI® evenly over the affected area. The recommended dose per application is **up to 1 gram.**

Do not spot treat for best results and wash your hands after application



Repeat

Use WINLEVI® once in the morning and once in the evening

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF WINLEVI®

- Local skin irritation such as itching, burning, skin redness, peeling, scaling, dryness
- Change of hair colour at the area of application

STORING AND DISCARDING WINLEVI®

- Keep at room temperature (20°C to 25°C)
- Do not freeze
- WINLEVI® should be discarded 180 days after the date of
- dispensing or 6 months after first opening, whichever is sooner





- use in close contact with the eyes, lips, mouth, or vagina as well as areas with cuts, scratches, rashes or sunburns
 - You should also avoid the corners of the nose and mucous membranes (the inner lining of some organs or body cavities)
 - If contact with mucous membranes occurs, rinse immediately and thoroughly with water
- share with other people, even if they have the same symptoms you have, as it may harm them
- use skin products that may dry or irritate your skin (such as medicated or abrasive soaps and cleansers, soaps, cleansers, and cosmetics that have strong skin drying effects, products that contain high amounts of alcohol and astringents [used to dry or shrink skin tissue], spices, or lime)
- use other than exactly as your healthcare professional tells you to
